### **South Fayette Graduates Recognized as AP Scholars**

*South Fayette Township, PA* – Six graduates of South Fayette High School have earned the designation of AP Scholar by the College Board in recognition of their exceptional achievement on the college-level Advanced Placement Program (AP) Exams taken throughout their high school careers. Approximately 17 percent of the more than one million high school students worldwide who took the AP Exams performed at a sufficiently high level to merit the recognition of AP Scholar.

At South Fayette, Dillon Collins qualified for the AP Scholar with Distinction Award by earning an average grade of at least 3.5 on all AP Exams taken and grades of 3 or higher on five or more of these exams. Additionally, R.J. Bendis and Eric Kaupinis qualified for the AP Scholar with Honor Award by earning an average grade of least 3.25 on all AP Exams taken and grades of 3 or higher on four or more of these exams. Laura Martinelli, Sara Schuchert, and Karin Steinbock qualified for the AP Scholar Award by completing three or more AP Exams with grades of 3 or higher.

With a wide variety of Advanced Placement courses offered in the curriculum, South Fayette students have the opportunity to earn over 30 college credit prior to graduation through the AP exams.
