Reasons documented for referrals:

- Four referrals were made for students being “loud and disruptive”
- Two referrals were made for “minor harassment”
- Two referrals were made for a physical altercation
- One referral was made for a student repeatedly getting off at the wrong bus stop and refusing to bring parent permission to do so.
