## Registration Procedures

### Applications

Separate applications should be completed for every child. An application can be found on the last page of this booklet. At registration, parents and students will meet instructors and have the opportunity to ask any specific questions at that time. After April 27, applications will be accepted at the elementary receptionist's office. Students who are in **grades K-6 for the 2008-2009 school year are eligible.** Please see the course descriptions for grade levels.

### Payment

Checks should be made out to South Fayette School District. Your check should include the cost for tuition, PLUS lab fees and a t-shirt cost of \$5, if applicable. See individual course descriptions for tuition and applicable lab fees. If a course is cancelled by Little Lions' Academy, tuition/lab fees will be returned. **Tuition will not be refunded for any other reason.**

Sign up will be held on a first come, first served basis. Family members are encouraged to register their own children. If a course is filled, you may wish to make an alternate choice. A completed application form and payment (including lab fees) will be required at the time of registration. **Please note that registration is not complete until payment is received in full.** A waiting list will be available once class limits are reached.

Non-residents may register after April 27. An additional \$5 fee will be assessed to all non-resident applications.

### Location

Classes will be located in the South Fayette Elementary School, in most cases. Students are to be dropped off/picked up **PROMPTLY.** Drop off begins at 9:15 a.m.

**NOTE:** All students will receive a Little Lions' Academy "reminder" during the last week of June prior to the start of the program.
