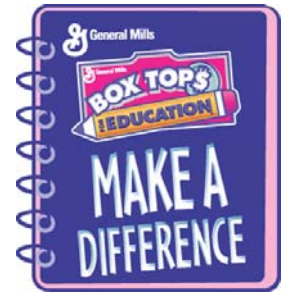


We Need Your Help!



South Fayette Elementary School can receive up to \$20,000 annually in **each** of the Box Tops for Education program's three components: Clip, Shop and Charge. **We use this money for the summer reading program and other reading initiatives.**



You can help by:

1. Clipping Box Tops for Education from hundreds of participating General Mills products. Box Tops are worth 10 cents each when our school redeems them from General Mills. These items (along with Campbell's Soup labels and Shop-N-Save receipts) can be placed in the collection boxes at the school office, at the township library, at the Senior Citizen's Center, at South Fayette's preschool, at Gladden Church, and at the Cuddy, Morgan, Presto and Sturgeon post offices.
2. Signing up for the Box Tops Booster club at boxtops4education.com and designating S Fayette Township Elementary PTA/PTO – McDonald, PA (15057) when you sign up. Up to 8 percent of your purchase is donated to your designated school when you visit the Box Tops Marketplace at boxtops4education.com before making a purchase from a participating merchant. **When you enroll in the Booster club, you can elect to not receive any e-mails or special offers from General Mills, if desired.**

Please consider using the Box Tops Marketplace if you purchase items online for yourself or for a small business. Many companies that you probably shop at anyway (such as Staples, OfficeMax, Office Depot and Barnes & Noble) participate in this program.

3. Considering replacing your current credit card with the Box Tops for Education Visa Card, which earns your designated school 1 percent of your total purchases. Please call 1-800-650-0235 to compare this card's terms with those of your current reward card.
4. Trimming some (or all) of your box tops along the dotted lines before placing them in a designated collection box. Last year a small group of volunteers spent more than 300 hours trimming and assembling box tops. You can help us to greatly reduce our processing time by carefully trimming some (or all) of your box tops. Please do not let children trim the box tops unless they can trim them without accidentally cutting off the expiration date. We don't get credit for box tops with cut off expiration dates.
