## Middle School Breakfast "Free" Buffet

First, Students can select a Breakfast Grain - Select one
Take up to 2 fruits (juice counts as a fruit, however, students can only select one juice per day)
Your CHOICE can be 1 fruit, 1 juice (both)
OR two fruit (and no juice)
OR just 1 juice
OR 1 fruit
Students cannot choose 2 juices. Students must take at least (1) item from the fruit station to make a free breakfast. If they don't take at least one item from the juice/fruit station, they will be charged ala carte pricing - PA regulations.


Add Milk - Only if you are going to drink it. You are NOT required to take a MILK
Please don't waste - if you don't think you will drink it, please don't take it.
