

Student Parking

The start of the 2019-2020 school year is rapidly approaching. It is time for those students who wish to drive to school to obtain their annual parking permit. Student parking at the High School is in the **rear parking lot** and **stadium lot**. Students may only park in these locations. Student parking is on a first come/first served basis. Once the spaces in the rear and stadium lots have been sold, there will be no additional spots.

Student drivers will receive a parking tag for their vehicle, which must be displayed on the rearview mirror at all times while on campus. Student driving privileges are extended to junior and senior drivers only. The cost of the driving permit is **\$50.00** for a full year and **\$25.00**

for a semester. This fee will cover the cost of the parking tags with any remaining monies to be used to support student activities at the High School. Student parking passes may be obtained at the **Student Center** in the High School building at the following times.

SENIORS ONLY Monday, August 12 - 7:30 a.m. to 2:30 p.m. and Tuesday, August 13 - 12:00 p.m. to

JUNIORS AND SENIORS Wednesday and Thursday, August 14 and 15 – 7:30 a.m. to 2:30 p.m.

The following conditions must be adhered to in order for students to retain their parking passes:

1. Students may only park in the rear lot and stadium lot.
2. All student parking spaces are numbered. The space number corresponds to the number on the parking tag. Students must park in their designated space.
3. Students must have a valid Pennsylvania driver's license at the time of registration. Parking passes will not be reserved for those with a learner's permit.
4. Permits are issued numerically. Students may not request a specific space. Students may not "swap" parking permits. Students must obtain their own parking pass.
5. All student driving regulations on the parking permit application and in the Student-Parent Handbook **MUST** be followed. Failure to do so will result in revocation of parking privileges. Permit fees are **NON-REFUNDABLE** for any reason.
6. Students are expected to be in their first period class by 7:20 a.m. Allow extra time to obey speed limits and walk from your designated space. Excessive "tardies" will result in loss of parking privileges. Please pay particular attention to items #10 and #11 on the application.
7. A complete listing of regulations for student drivers is included in the Student-Parent Handbook. Please review them carefully.

Applications can also be obtained on the District website or in the Student Center. Please return the **completed** application with both parent and student signatures and cash or check (payable to *South Fayette High School*), during the dates and times specified above, to Mrs. Alice Kamphaus, located in the High School Student Center. Applications will not be accepted before August 12th. **All students will need to bring his/her current license, insurance information and vehicle registration to be copied in order to receive a permit.** This procedure also applies to Parkway West students. Please be sure that your child has all required documentation at the time of registration, as spaces cannot be reserved for those who do not have all the documentation in hand at the time of application.

1. Students must park where assigned and have their parking permit displayed on rear view mirror.
2. Student must park in their assigned spaces and in designated student parking lots during school hours. Students who do not park in their assigned space and /or do not park in a student lot will be subject to disciplinary actions.
3. Student drivers should arrive no earlier than 6:50 A.M. and must be seated in first period class by 7:20 A.M.
4. Students may not go to their cars during the school day or leave school grounds unless given permission from the principal or a Dean of Students. Students who are given such permission will be accompanied to their vehicle.
5. Student must observe all Pennsylvania State driving laws.
6. All cars parked in the parking lot must be locked.
7. All school district policies including those that prohibit the possession or use of weapons, drugs, alcohol or tobacco apply to student drivers. Any vehicle parked on school property is subject to search for reasonable suspicion related to the health, safety, or well-being of the students.
8. **DRIVERS CANNOT EXIT THE SCHOOL UNTIL THE BUSES HAVE DEPARTED AND THE ANNOUNCEMENT HAS BEEN MADE FOR CAR RIDERS TO DEPART.**
9. A complete listing of regulations for student drivers is included in the Student Parent Handbook. Please review them carefully with your child.
10. Student drivers TARDY to school **four (4) times** will have their permit suspended for ten(10) school days.
11. Students drivers TARDY to school **five (5) times** will have their permit suspended for forty-five(45)school days. **More than five (5) tardies**, permit will be revoked for the remainder of the school year with no refunds.

VIOLATION OF THE REGULATIONS ABOVE WILL RESULT IN IMMEDIATE REVOCATION OF YOUR PARKING PERMIT FOR THE REMAINDER OF THE SEMESTER. NO EXCEPTIONS WILL BE MADE. STUDENTS WHO DRIVE TO SCHOOL AFTER THEIR PARKING PERMIT HAS BEEN REVOKED WILL BE ASSIGNED ADDITIONAL CONSEQUENCES.
