Just a friendly reminder that 6th grade students need to have a physical turned in from this school year or last (June 2019 onward) per the PA Department of Health. If you have not already submitted a copy of your child's wellness check and updated immunizations, letters will be mailed out next week with a permission slip for the District physician to perform a physical on your child. NO IMMUNIZATIONS will be given. The physician will be on campus April 22.

7th grade students are required to have a dental exam completed per the PA Department of Health. If you have not already submitted a copy of your child's dental exam dated May 2020 or later, letters will be mailed out next week with a permission slip for the District dentist to perform a visual exam on your child. This is NOT A CLEANING and NO X RAYS will be taken. The dentist will be on campus April 8.
